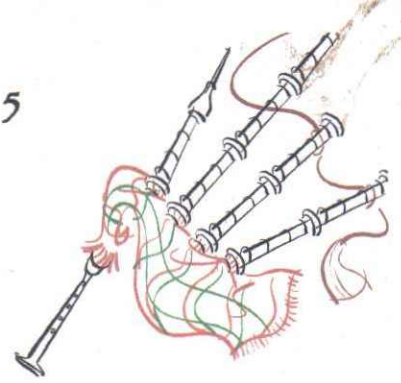


# Piping on the Green Celtic Music and Craft Fair 2015

## By signing this contract the vendor agrees to:

- ☞ Pay the specified booth rental fee of **\$40.00** for a 10' x 10' booth space. Tents and tables must be provided by vendor.
- ☞ All applications and appropriate fees **must be** turned in no later than March 1, 2015. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- ☞ Any materials Piping on the Green deems obscene, dangerous, unlawful or otherwise inappropriate for a family friendly environment is strictly prohibited from sales, promotion, display or advertisement in any way. **Piping on the Green reserves the right to remove any article deemed not suitable for this event.**
- ☞ **No alcohol, drugs, or firearms are permitted.**
- ☞ Arts & Crafts vendors are not allowed to sponsor raffles, sell food or beverages, or solicit donations.
- ☞ We request that the majority of Vendors and Artisans items for sale be hand-crafted and we require all items are of good quality. A limited number of "factory-made" product vendors will be allowed. Remembering that this is a Celtic event, we ask that vendors include Celtic-themed items in their merchandise.
- ☞ Vendors must list items they will be selling, distributing, promoting, or demonstrating. Example: craft items, promotion material, etc. Please be as specific as possible. *Please include with application, at least two (2) photos of booth and merchandise being sold, promoted, displayed, or marketed.*
- ☞ All vendor sales, demonstrations, and marketing shall be conducted within the designated space rented by the vendor. Booths must be managed at all times.
- ☞ We reserve the right to limit vendor types to encourage a variety and prevent overlap.
- ☞ All property belonging to any vendor will be the sole responsibility of the owner. The City of Tullahoma, Coffee County, The Celtic Cup Coffee House, Highland Rim Scottish Society, and Piping on the Green will not be responsible for missing or damaged property.
- ☞ Each vendor will be responsible for keeping their area free of trash and debris within and immediately around their individual spaces and when each vendor removes their equipment, merchandise and materials from their space at the conclusion of the event.
- ☞ Vendor set up times begin at 6:30 a.m. the day of the event. All vehicles must be off the grounds and moved to designated parking area by 8:00 a.m. Sales may begin at 8:00 a.m.
- ☞ Music Event is from 9:00 a.m. till 6:00 p.m. All vendors are required to stay open until 6:00 p.m. No early vendor break-down.
- ☞ Please note: your booth registration is not complete until you have paid all booth rental fees and filed all applicable paperwork with the Piping on the Green Committee. Confirmation will be sent.
- ☞ The vendor must bring their State Tax-Exempt Certificate to the event.
- ☞ No pets allowed, please.
